



## VIP COURTESY PASS PROGRAM

Since 1995, Spartanburg School District 2 has offered its senior citizens age 60 and above and retired District 2 employees a courtesy pass that entitles them to free admission to regular season school athletic events; the card may be accepted with certain restrictions/exceptions for other school-sponsored events such as plays (VIP/teacher night) and concerts.

Currently, Spartanburg and Greenville county schools have a reciprocal agreement to honor the passes. Benefits do not include athletic tournaments, post-season play, pageants, events requiring advance ticket sales, or events not sponsored by the school.

The Spartanburg School District 2 VIP Courtesy Pass is a lifetime membership card. It must be presented to receive benefits, is valid as long as the program continues, and is not transferable (it is accepted only for the person pictured on the card).

Senior citizens residing in another Spartanburg school district or in Greenville should contact their home district's administrative offices for information on obtaining a similar card sponsored by that district.

Eligible residents may obtain the Spartanburg School District 2 VIP Courtesy Pass by following these three steps:

1. Please **call 578-0128 to make an appointment**. Calling ahead for an appointment will minimize wait time and ensure that someone will be available to assist you.
2. Remember to bring with you **proof of your age and District 2 residence**, both of which must be verified to qualify for the pass.
3. When you arrive, sign in with the receptionist in the lobby of the District 2 Administrative Offices, located at 3231 Old Furnace Road. The Office of Public Relations will take your photograph and then will prepare the card while you wait (usually about 15–20 minutes) or will mail it to you.
